NONRESIDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE)*

Allows recipients to pay 150% of the resident rate.

To receive the WUE award:

- minimum 3.20 unweighted cumulative GPA and 22 ACT/1020 SAT
- submit all admission application materials by February 15, 2011

Gem Scholarship*

Waives the nonresident portion of tuition and is available for all qualified nonresident students.

To receive the Gem award:

- minimum 3.60 unweighted cumulative GPA and 27 ACT/1210 SAT
- submit all admission application materials by February 15, 2011

*Not all academic majors are eligible for Gem and WUE scholarships and are subject to change.
