ESTIMATED COSTS FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2009/2010

The following costs are for the 2009/2010 academic year, which is in session from mid-August to mid-May. The costs usually increase between 3-10 percent per academic year. Exact amounts will be available in April of each year. **The estimated costs are for the full academic year and are subject to change at any time.**

Do I need to pay the full-time fees? If you plan to enter the United States with the F-1 or J-1 student visa, you are required to register for a minimum of 12 credits if you are an undergraduate, and 9 credits if you are a graduate student. International students pay the full-time fees plus nonresident fees.

Do I need to submit financial documentation? If you plan to enter the United States with the F-1 or J-1 visa or are currently in the United States with the F-1 or J-1 visa and plan to transfer to Boise State, you will need to submit financial documentation to show you have the funds available to support you for one full year, and a funding plan for subsequent years. If you are currently in the United States with a different visa classification and plan to change to the F-1 or J-1 status, you will need to submit the financial documentation also. If you are currently in the United States with a different visa classification and do not plan to change to the F-1 or J-1 status, you will not need to submit any financial documentation.

Scholarships or Assistantships? If your admission application is complete by the scholarship deadline of February 15 for the following fall semester, you will be considered for any available scholarships. Scholarships are competitive and awarded based on grade point average (GPA). Graduate students can apply for an assistantship through the department of their major, before the specified deadline. If you are applying for, or receiving, a scholarship or assistantship, the amount of the scholarship or assistantship would count towards the full amount you are required to document as available to you. You would then need to show documentation for the remaining estimated costs.

Financial Aid? International students who are in the United States with a visa do not qualify for any type of aid program that is federally funded. A provision of the student visa is that federal financial aid may not be accepted.

Restrictions – Due to the consistent, extreme difficulties students from Nigeria, Ghana, Cameroon and Kenya are experiencing in receiving funds to pay for tuition and fees, books, and living expenses, special procedures are necessary. **If your funding source is located in Nigeria, Ghana, Cameroon or Kenya, you are required to send a deposit for the entire amount of the total academic cost of your first year's expenses. Payments toward this deposit are allowed, but the full amount must be received before the admission deadline.** The deposit must be in the form of a check or bank draft, made payable to Boise State University. The money is returned to those who are inadmissible or decide not to attend.
