The Master of Business Administration (MBA) is a high quality academic program for tomorrow's business leaders. The MBA in Information Technology Management is a new customized MBA designed for IT professionals. The Executive MBA is for professionals seeking broader responsibility in their organizations.

The MS in Accountancy (MSA) or MSA-Taxation (MSAT) provide focused graduate education in accountancy and advanced taxation issues.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are available to students demonstrating ability to achieve in academic fields. This year, business majors will receive almost \$300,000.

RESIDENTIAL COLLEGE

The Business and Economics Community of the Residential College (housed in Taylor Hall) is comprised of students in business-related majors. Students enroll for one academic credit for this living-learning community, where they participate in activities that provide a better understanding of business as well as community service projects and social functions. Research indicates that students who make meaningful connections with faculty are more successful.

Those admitted to the COBE Community live and interact with other students and the faculty in residence. Unique events, including guests from the business world and larger community, informal conversations with faculty and special events add a unique dimension to college life. COBE students created and manage the Dawson's 4.0 coffee shop. All students must apply for University Housing and complete an application to gain admission to the program.

PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCES

College of Business and Economics' faculty and more than 3,000 majors benefit from the college's location in an active business community. Experienced business people often visit Boise State classrooms to share their experiences and involve students in actual business case projects. This professional experience provides students practical business settings where they apply classroom knowledge.

Beyond the classroom, Idaho companies, non-profit organizations and government institutions provide opportunities for advanced students to develop business skills through internships. STUDENT SERVICES CENTER

The college's Student Services Center acts as an information hub and advising center for the university's business majors.
